The ReStore accepts building materials, furniture, major appliances, small appliances, housewares, and home décor. Building materials include, but are not limited to, lumber, plumbing, electric, cabinets, counter tops, sinks, tubs, flooring, hardware, tools and equipment, etc.

1. Habitat accepts items that are in good clean condition and in working order. Based on inventory and need, the store may choose not to accept certain items for a period of time. This decision will be made by the store manager.
2. We do not accept partial paint cans, poisons, firearms, and other chemicals or hazardous materials.
3. We do not accept for sale any clothes, purses, shoes, hats, or handbags.
4. Habitat does not accept typewriters, satellite dishes, large computer monitors (flat screen ok), computers older than Windows 98, organs, console TVs or radios, paint (we do accept new from businesses), piano's (electric keyboards and small spinets ok), carpet padding (unless in excellent condition), mirrors without frames.
5. Habitat's "DO NOT ACCEPT" list will be posted and may change based on store needs by the ReStore Manager.
6. Cars, trucks, and RVs must be in running condition with a clear title. Boats must be on a trailer with title. We use Habitat for Humanity Car's for Homes programs for these donations. Please refer donors to the ReStore Manager for processing.
7. Donations of land, mobile homes, stock, etc, must be referred to the administrative office for processing.
8. Donations can only be picked up by our trucks within the Allegheny County boundary.
9. All donations must be boxed or bagged. Construction items must be bundled and/ or tied together.
